## DEVICE CONFIGURATION

Access the device page via a web browser. Note that the device must have a display. Select **Device Settings** → **SIP**. Under SIP General Settings, change *Use IR Remote* to "Yes". Save the settings, and reboot the device.

If using a configuration file, include the following entry:

```
<SIPConfig
  use_ir_remote="1"
  <!--other SIP settings here-->
/>
```

## REMOTE SETUP

1. Press and hold the **SETUP** button until the red indicator stays on, then release the SETUP button.
2. Press and release the **TV** mode button. The red indicator blinks, then stays lit.
3. Enter the 4 digit code **0010**.  
*Note: after a valid code entry, the red indicator turns off. For an invalid code, the red indicator flashes.*

## AVAILABLE FUNCTIONS

- 0-9** Dial a SIP extension by pressing keypad number buttons in the desired order.
- Backspace to delete numbers while dialing. In SIP phone mode, backspace rejects incoming call. If in an active call, this button will hang up the call.
- Enter** Place a call to the SIP extension entered. In SIP phone mode, this button answers the incoming call.
- Mute** Mutes the microphone on the device.
- Vol+/Vol-** In firmware 1.5 and later, controls volume level of current call. Note that any volume level changes do not stay in place after the call ends. The device will return to the programmed speaker volume level on the next call.
- Info** Displays the current call status (active or idle).
